PASTOR LISA'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is the beginning of a new year! I hope that all of you have had a blessed Christmas holiday and are enjoying the new year. January is a special time for me. I began my first pastoral appointment on January 1, 1997. Port Murray UMC was a congregation that had been around for over a hundred years when I got there. The total membership, not worship attendance, the total membership was 18. No, I haven't left off any zeros. 18 people. Total. Children included. They were deeply suspicious of women pastors and the fact that I was all of 25 years old wasn't helping anything. It was a year of firsts – my first funeral only 2 weeks after I arrived, my first baptism, my first wedding, my first Christmas service, my first Easter service. They wound up being a wonderful congregation for a rookie pastor, and I still exchange Christmas cards with some of them.

Each new year brings new challenges and new celebrations. We are still in our first year journeying in ministry together. This year we will make our first journey through Lent and celebrate Easter together for the first time. I am bringing a couple of new ministry offerings for the new year. First, I am offering a short-term Sunday evening study beginning January 19 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gathering Place, called "Radicle Methodism". This is joint effort of the General Board of Discipleship and the General Board of Archives and History which looks at the origins of the Methodist movement. We will meet for 4 Sundays. Everyone is welcome. There is no charge for the study.

Second, I will be starting a sermon series on January 12 based on the book, "Soul Reset" by Junius B. Dotson. Sometimes we feel burned out after the excitement and busyness of the holidays wears off. The book was born from Rev. Dotson's experience of depression and burnout in ministry. He shares what he learned about self-care and soul-care. I will be sharing some of his lessons along with my own experiences. I hope this series will be helpful to you all as we begin a new year together.

Thank you all for your expressions of love and kindness during Christmas. I am blessed and honored to be your pastor. I can't wait to see what God is going to do in our lives and in our church in 2025. I pray you all have a joyous New Year.


